Though James is 21 years of age, he is still in high school and remains in the protective care of the In Heaven's Eyes Center (IHE Center) in Nyahururu, Kenya East Africa. He *needed* a loving parent to ensure that his special requirements were met so that he could get to the next level of his life. His mother abandoned him and was later jailed as a result. Hungry, he hit the streets in search of food. Thank **GOD** for allowing him to be rescued by IHE. Notice I said "*needed!*" Minister Wheeler heeded the soft, still voice of GOD calling her to become his parent. Thanks be to **GOD**, our **FATHER in Heaven**, for not only touching her heart but for encouraging her to move forward with his adoption. His "*needed*" became "*has!*" He will complete his high school journey in December 2025. We are grateful for her obedience and willingness to obey and please **GOD**.

Secondly, Stephen Githinji is sixteen years old and in his final year of Junior High school. Stephen was entrusted to his father's care. After his mother was arrested and jailed for drunkenness and abuse, his father became abusive as well. As a result, he and his brother ran away from home and lived in the streets until they were rescued by IHE. They have remained at the Center ten (10) years, since 2015. He now has a loving, caring and highly anointed adoptive parent, Apostle Dr. Carolyn L. Vessel, who provides for his needs. Stephen will join Senior High School in 2026. He will never have to worry about being abused or hungry ever again.

Last, but certainly not least, sweet little seven-year-old, Melani Nachupai, and her sister were abandoned by the roadside because their parents were unable to feed them. Resources were scarce. A good Samaritan rescued them and reported their situation to the police. Shortly thereafter, they were placed at the IHE Center for care and protection as well. They are not only surviving but thriving! This little girl's story touched the very heart of Elder Patsy Gardner who knew, without a doubt, that she was to be the adoptive parent of little Melani.

**GOD** has been gracious to CLWC (Co-Labourers With Christ) in this final quarter of 2024 as HE has allowed the ministry to flourish beyond belief. We are extremely **grateful, blessed, and ecstatic** by the fact that **HE** gave three (3) of **HIS** beautifully anointed children brand new loving parents.
